The building for the school has progressed tremendously. Thanks again for all your prayers and financial help. We will be able to house thirty more children. We are looking forward for the government to remove some covid restrictions so we can get a full student body, so as to help enhanced our finances to pay bills.

**DECEMBER 2020**.....Despite all of the covid restrictions, it didn't stop couples from getting married. I was very busy counseling and marrying couples. It was a good thing to see folk who were living together unmarried, getting saved and married. We have

seen three persons saved during our soul winning, and is now coming to the house of worship.

We do hope everyone had a great Christmas. Our Christmas holidays were spent working on our school building. We must do the work.

**JANUARY 2020**.....We all praise the Lord for the new year He has given us. We do hope that we don't have to go through what we have gone through in 2020. Our next door neighbour celebrated his hundredth(100) years. Our school sang the birthday song to him

On our Sunday soul winning, we have led a family of five to Jesus Christ. They are going to be enrolled in our converts class. Praise God for saving souls.

**FEBRUARY 2021**.....The Lord continues to shine His grace and kindness on us here at Heritage Baptist Church. The Lord has allowed me to lead another thirteen year old boy to Christ. That was my age when I got saved. My goal is to train him for ministries.

We have celebrated our forty seventh year of independence of our country. The eighth was a holiday, so we spent it cooking our national dish on the church compound. We did some work on our church road entrance to accommodate the bringing of two twenty foot containers for the purpose of rooms for Sunday school.
