While the Bible belt has swollen up in lukewarmness, other regions, particularly the Midwest and New England, have been spiritually starving for decades, and I'm thankful that you see the mission field that America still is.

Over the past couple of months since I started deputation, the primary goal was to join with FBHM, prepare prayer cards and create lists of pastors to call. Due to the incredible support of my pastor, before I even received my prayer cards, churches around Gaffney have called, interested in my work.

While at work, I received a call that Knotty Oaks Baptist Church, in Coventry, Rhode Island, had already voted by faith to support my mission. The love and support that I receive from you through your prayers mean the world to me, and I can't thank you enough.

Two weeks ago, Victory Baptist Church of Gaffney, SC, took me on for support. In total, I now have three churches that support my mission, with another church having voted on me earlier this week. I also have many meetings to look forward to in the next several weeks.
