Thank God in the middle of June of this year a new sister came to congregate with us, she saw the situation we were in and the limits we had in our garage of the house and invited us to move to the temple that her deceased husband built years ago, in a very central place, in front of the City Mall with many parking, air conditioning etc. Well, by the grace of God we are receiving new families and the spirit in the church has been renewed. We now have in attendance up to 50. In less than six months we have already covered 80% of the expectation we had in attendance by the end of the year. We are praying now to fill the second floor that the church has, as it is qualified to receive about 150 people. God has been good to us.

Family: I thank God for the opportunity God gave me to see my three daughters and their families in the month of July. God used Pastor Noé Mendoza greatly and as always to shelter us and give us accommodation so that this would become a reality. With my wife we are very grateful. Please also pray for the coming of our third grandson in this case the first boy in the family of my third daughter Juliet who will be born in December and will be called Judah she lives in North Wilkesboro N.C. with her husband Jordan. We ask God to keep Juliet in her pregnancy until the day of the birth.

Missions: We were visiting South Texas and preaching in some churches and it was a blessing there, but God also opened the doors of opportunity to travel to South Carolina and preach for three weeks at the North Side Church of Una, SC. to get to know the work and see the possibility of shepherding that church one day. We believe that although with my wife we feel that it is not yet our time to leave the work in Honduras, although we have an open heart for change in the near future. If there were clear conditions for someone to invest in legal paperwork that is the most difficult and we would see God's hand approving a legal immigration status, then we would do it. It was a blessing to also be and preach with other pastors like Pastor Clark in N.C. and his Hispanic work.
