Dear Co-Laborers in Christ,

Greetings once again in the precious name of our Savior. What a joy it is to serve the King of Kings! We continue to see the Lord drawing people to Himself.

There was a lady named Sandra that came to church for a short time eight years ago. She chose to continue living in prostitution and alcohol, but faithfully sent her two youngest children to Sunday school each week. We visited Sandra many times but she never returned to church. In late December her daughter called to tell me that Sandra had been rushed to the hospital. Unfortunately she received the wrong treatment and her condition worsened. When we visited her in early February, the first thing she said when we entered her hospital room was, “I got my heart right with the Lord.” She could speak only a little, but it was obvious that she had clearly understood the Gospel the many times we had shared it with her. A week later, she passed into eternity. This has been a difficult time for her family, but her two older children, a sister and two nieces have started attending church as a result.

Just a few days after Sandra passed away, a neighbor lady named Consuelo also passed into eternity. Consuelo was usually friendly with us, as long as we didn't talk about religion. Last fall she was diagnosed with liver cancer and given only a short time to live. I went to visit her and thought I'd try one more time to share God's free gift of salvation with her. To my surprise, when I arrived, she told me she had already placed her faith in Jesus Christ. God had used her brother, who is a pastor in another city, to share the Good News with Consuelo before it was too late. Through this, one of her daughters and a granddaughter have come back to the Lord.

In the midst of God's many blessings, we had an unexpected trial. On March 7, I was in a terrible car accident. I had dropped everyone off in the village after church and was on my way back home when I was hit by a drunk driver. We nearly had a head-on collision, but I was able to move slightly out of the way so instead the Hilux bashed into the rear tire on the driver's side, causing my car to roll four times. Miraculously neither I nor the other driver suffered any injuries. We are learning that insurance laws and regulations don't work like they do in the States. Being the driver at fault was in an in-briated state, the insurance company wouldn't stand good for damages to either vehicle. Fortunately the man who hit me is a man of means and is paying to fix up our vehicle. In the meantime, a man from our church has graciously let us use one of his cars.

We are so grateful for your prayers and can see God's hand of protection over us. We love each of you and pray God continues to richly bless you!
