Spring is here in our area so it is time to begin planting our garden again this year between meetings and travels. I love this time of year when things come back to life. We have been able to preach several Revivals and Missions Conferences in these two months. It is great to see new life in the churches as well.

We just finished training class at Lincolnton Correctional to keep our blue cards current for the next year. We have one more class next month at another Prison. We are hoping to get in to at least one more Prison this year as we are able. We are thankful for Brother Ian Danner helping us and filling in for me when I am unable to be there. His wife also went to the training class at Lincolnton so hopefully soon she will be able to join us as well. Pray for more laborers in the harvest.

Brother Claudius Harry's wife passed away on February 13th. I Flew down to St. Vincent, March 6-11, to be at the funeral. Brother and Sister Harry were married over 60 years.
