Our ministry is slowly growing. The Lord had given us opportunity to start our new mission work while working hand in hand with the Honiara Bible Baptist Church. We are still planting Gospel seed on the Eastern side of Honiara which is in the vicinity of the Henderson International airport. **EASTERN GATE INDEPENDENT BAPTIST MISSIONS** is the name of our future church to be as soon as we officially announce the birth of our ministry. We currently have fifteen (15) kids that attends our prayer meeting fellowship on Wednesdays. We also have our Bible club ministry on Thursday's and have six (6) plus kids we attend to. Our soul winning and gospel tract passing is daily, and visitations on Sunday evenings).

While on the other Western side where the Honiara town ground is, locates Honiara Bible Baptist Church, and Pacific Light Baptist church in the heart of Honiara Township. So currently we have two Independent Baptist Church in Honiara, and ours makes three (3). While attending Honiara Bible Baptist Church, I also help



assist with the preaching and song leading at times when am given opportunity to. Our financial support takes us through the month covering food, travelling expenses, bills such a; house rentals, water, electric, gas for cooking and hospital bills; no less no more. And thankfully we receive our support on time, and that speaks volumes of itself. Honiara people are very friendly, trouble free, touristic and yet so religious and lost. Living standards a bit

expensive though. We are catching up with their PENGLISH (Pidgin English), and we're gradually communicating with them. We gladly had two souls saved; one last year, and the other this year while ministering in HBBC, and for our ministry, we're keep laboring. Had our first Christmas and New Year away from home. Was very challenging but we've learnt to sing like Apostle Paul & Silas in the prison, and so far all is well by God's Grace even through thick and thin.
