As the days and months go by, I am thankful for the goodness and faithfulness of the Lord. While I am still preaching 4 services a week, the Lord is sending some more men to help in the ministry. I am looking forward to seeing what the Lord is going to do this year in the prisons. The attendance has increased at the Sunday morning services. I have started preaching through the book of 1 Corinthians. On Monday and Tuesday nights, I am preaching a series on Biblical doctrine. Please pray for the services as some of these men have never heard about some of the major doctrines of the Word of God. Though new to some of them they seem to be soaking up the truths of the Bible. In March, we will be going to a prison in NC for prison training. Brother Joe Hendricks, a dear brother and missionary with Living Letters Prison Ministry, handles most of the NC prison services and has a monthly service there. Please pray as we are planning to try and schedule some revival meetings this year. Since Covid we have not been able to have any revival meetings.
