This year we celebrated ten years as a church in the Soesdyke area. We praise the Lord for being part of the ministry from its inception and for all these years. We will continue to bring folks on the van, knock on doors and to keep spreading the seed of the gospel for it is the power of God unto salvation.

We could not have done this without dear friends the Lord has placed in our lives. Friends who have kept close, supported and encouraged us throughout the years. Some have also visited as often as they can from the USA. Last October the Lord brought our way, our mission board director and his wife, our South American director on their first visit to Guyana, along with Bro. Joe Hendricks and his wife who has been here about six times before. We get to spend some time and good fellowship with them, though they were here for a meeting at a different church for a short time.

If you have had a chance to read a few of our previous letters you would see we do not have a land or building for Church and we have had to move from our first location. We are currently meeting under a shed, on a plot of land we were allowed to use for the time. This land is now being sold and the church will have to move again.

This year one of our main prayers has been to find a plot of land suitable for the church. We believe the Lord has led us in that direction. Recently in the month of November, we were able to locate a plot of land which is being sold for **USD \$35,000**. The cost also is much lesser than our previous inquiries. We believe the size and location of the land would be ideal for our church. The land owner said he will be willing to wait until January of next year for us to make the purchase. Would you please pray this is where the Lord would have us and for the funds to purchase the plot of land. We appreciate you lifting us up in your prayers and for any financial support the Lord will place on your heart to give. All funds can be sent to our mission board for due processing. We have been patiently waiting on the Lord and believe he will meet this need for us soon. It would be great especially for the children to have a separate area for Sunday School and eventually having them in a secure room from getting wet when there is rain and strong wind. The shed space has become inadequate for us to have Sunday School for both children and adults at the same time. Thank you for praying!
