Sharon, Rolston, Azali, Kel Greetings Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It has been a while since our last prayer letter; but we have continued to serve the Lord. Last November my Mom (Gloria Melville) went to be with the Lord. My Dad (Pedro Melville) I know misses her very much.

My wife Sharon is doing much better today, since the loss of our third child last August. She has developed some health problems and has been visiting the doctor. Sharon has been diagnosed with high blood pressure; which she is taking medication for, her heart is not functioning too normal and recently the doctors have seen kidney and gall stones.

Our mission board family, dear friends and supporters have been such a blessing to us financially, prayerfully and personally. Two weeks after Mom died it was a great blessing to see our dear friends' evangelist Joe Hendricks and his wife Becky again. Together we were in Prisons, schools and held three night revival meeting at our Church. The gospel of Christ was preached and hundreds of John and Romans booklets were distributed. Many souls accepted Christ and believers were revived. Praise the Lord!!

2019 started with my family moving from the house we were renting to another house in the next village. Praise the Lord we are still close to the Church. Some afternoons my children even enjoy the 30 min walk to Church. Even though my son Kel also enjoys the fun of all four of us on my motorcycle. Our new home has many more people living in the street, which give us the opportunity to know and invite more folks to Church. Few services now I have had to make a couple of trips on my motorcycle taking children to church. Our Church is currently praying about hiring a bus (minivan) on Sundays to take people to Church very soon OR for the Lord to provide a vehicle that will fit this purpose and also serve my family needs.

In January I resigned from my job to invest more time in the ministry. My intention was to do something that will not take up much time as a full time job, but it has been more difficult for me than expected. I thank the Lord so much for the four supporters who have been supporting us for over a year now and for those that send support from time to time. Thank you so much for being a blessing & helping to meet the needs of my family.

Over two years ago I made a down payment on a piece of land to build a home for my family, this year God has provided the final amount for us to secure a 40X80 plot. This land is about a mile and a quarter from where the church currently meets. My desire is to build a home that would also house the Church. Since the Church is still meeting under a shed on a piece of land that we are only allowed to use until the owner is ready for it. My prayer is to have a place ready before the church is ask to move again. My prayer is for God to provide the finances very soon for us to start building. I know God is able to provide the finances. The house planned to build is a 30x40 in size. To begin with to build a strong foundation and frame of this house will at least cost USD \$9000. The total amount to complete the house would cost around USD\$30,000. Few young men I know are ready to volunteer their energies to help with building and other local churches with which we fellowship.

Anchor Baptist Church is continuing to grow each year. Truly our labor is not in vain and his word will not return void. Please pray for the genuinely saved in our church to be baptized, and for us to be a strong church that will anchor and build on the foundation of the word of God. We have need for Spanish Bibles and tracts since we have seen a steady influx of Venezuelans and Cubans in our country for some time now.

Finally brethren please pray that I will be approved for a USA visa this year for me to see your beautiful land so that I can share the work of the Lord we are doing here in Guyana.
