Covid 19 is ever present and cases have risen widely here in St Vincent over the past month. Folks who were temporarily displaced by the erupting of the volcano are back at their homes, at least those who had homes to return to. We continue to thank God for your prayer and continued support during those times.

At Gospel Light Baptist church we were able to have full services up until the month of September, at the moment we continue to meet at our church building for Sunday morning and bible study services. The challenge we face like most is keeping connected with our young people during this time. Thanks for your prayers concerning them; we have seen a lot of growth in quite a few of them which had been really encouraging to see. A number of them even started coming out to Sunday morning services, something that did not happen in the pass. Also we have over the last few years grown used to having open air meetings and our church family have looked forward to seeing people saved under the tents every year, it excites us all to see souls saved, even my children goes on about the tent all the time. Our prayer is that soon this kind of gathering would be allowed again!

My residence status is still unknown. We applied for permanent residence once again but with the volcano eruption, things have been pushed back so we are still awaiting an answer on our status here on the island, so please continue to pray with us. The kids are doing well. Zedekiah is not thrilled about having a new teacher, albeit online and Zara couldn't care less about changing teachers she is happy to be entering kindergarten, and is ready to go. My wife have not been doing the greatest lately, was able to get some test done and awaiting the results, so I would be grateful if you and lift her up in prayer.

I can't say enough on how grateful we are for your continued holistic support, its appreciated more than words can convey. We are well aware that most face the same challenges in these days and would continue to pray for you and the ministry that you are involved in.
