Dear Praying Friends and Partners

We are excited to come your way with what the Lord has been doing in our ministry and family in these three months. The Lord has been good to our family and ministry. By the grace of God we are healthy. Our church began the year with a medical outreach to our people. They were ministered to physically and spiritually. The team was able to look at of about 96 people and 47 of them from the community were saved at the end of the day. We also have three students from the college joining our church.

Prison Ministry: We are glad that our permit for 2025 has been renewed for my monthly visits to prisons this year and I have been able to visit all of the three prisons in February and March and about 156 people including both inmates and officers were reached with the gospel.

School Ministry: Our school ministry continued to suffer some setback as a result of breakdown in our motor bikes. Our letter of permission was not approved but it is all not lost for us. We are trusting God to touch the heart of the district officials who does these approval.

Bus Ministry: We started the year with a serious challenge with our bus ministry. The bus that we used broke down and we had to look for an alternative means which is not also strong for every week operations.

Church Planting: We are praying for the Sawla community and its environs, trusting the Lord to provide for a church planting activity in that community, where we do not have any Baptist church. We are asking your prayer support to enable us do the necessary preparations and ground works for a take-off of that ministry in 2025.

Children Ministry: We resumed our children's weekly meetings in February with over 50 children in attendance each week. Pray for these kids to respond to the gospel being preached to them every week. We are also looking forward to reach more children and set up more clubs in 2025. Consider sponsoring our Bible Clubs, there is a great need of educational materials for the children and gaming equipment (footballs, Volley Balls, nets, jerseys, etc.) for our club games. These items include: school bags, books, shoes, pens, pencils, and uniforms. We are trusting that the Lord will provide for us to meet these needs of the children, **\$50 per child will do a great deal of impact in the lives of these children.**

PRAYER REQUESTS:

- We are still trusting the Lord to provide regular support for our family and ministry. We are hoping that churches, families and individuals will consider to support us and our ministry in Ghana.
- Pray with us as my family prepares to receive two of our FBHM directors in April, Brother Keith and Evangelist Joe. It is our first time to host visitors like this in our ministry and there are lot of things new to us and we are trusting the Lord that their visit will be a blessing to our ministry.
- The ministry needs at least three new motorbikes to enable us move about well on ministry activities especially traveling to various schools. I am glad to report that my dad had a new motorbike from a generous friend of his. We are hoping the Lord will supply for these motorbikes as soon as possible to enhance our effective movement for our ministry. The costs of the three motors is about \$3800.00.
- Our church does not have its own church building and we are currently worshipping and fellowshiping in some people's building. The church is considering to purchase four (4) plots of land to build our own church house at a total cost of \$2600.00, with each plot costing \$650.00.
- Pray for my son's health (Ephraim) who has a heart disease
- Pray with us as we engage school authorities regarding access into government schools with the gospel.
- Join us to pray for the Sawla community as we look forward to planting a church in that community. We are also trusting the Lord to provide for the work to start and a man to take care of the souls that will be saved.

Please we encourage you to join us in bringing these urgent needs before the throne of grace and trust God for His blessings. I would encourage you, our co-laborers and Partners to be the source of God's provision to meet these prayer needs.

Please would you prayerfully consider being a part of our ministry in Ghana? Whether it is \$1, \$5, \$10, \$100 or even monthly support. Your "yes" would have an eternal everlasting impact on our ministry. Ecclesiastes 4:12 says, "A threefold cord is not quickly broken." YOU are the third cord in this ministry there with me while preaching, discipling, and sharing the love of Jesus!
