What a blessing to write to you from the comfort of our house, praying for you as a pastor and church for the protection and the trust in the Lord.

We are in the 46th day of the stay at home: every 15 days is being modified. This time it has been stated for another 15 days until May 12 supposedly we will be out of this obligated confinement. The measures by the government have been extreme here in Peru.

The church services have been transmitted online, discipleship, counseling, prayers, words of encouragement and all type of communication with the brethren have been through the social networks. By the grace of the Lord, no brethren of the church have been affected. We have lived these last 46 days to stay at home and has been modified several times also.

Now at 6pm and on Sundays, no one goes out. Fines and arrests are the means of the government. No one goes out on vehicles. There are only some buses for public use. Everything is controlled. Everything is by walking. The lines to buy food and institutions like banks and pharmacy are long. They are the only ones that can be opened.



It has been a time of social pressure and conflict at the time to make any time of movement. Only one person can go out and no children can go out. The public and private schools are cancelled. The classes are transmitted by TV or social networks. In the middle of so much restriction and chaos, the Lord has protected us and supplied every need like He has promised. Some brethren of the church has been affected also but the Lord has been good and are encouraged to keep trusting and waiting that all this will pass. They are attentive to the preaching and transmission in group. New way to do the ministry in this emergency. 58 saved.

Social distancing include masks, gloves, hand sanitizer, no verbal communication, washing the hands constantly in a repetitive way, of which sometimes it seems exaggerated but we trust in that the Lord will protect us in all this. We know that this shows that there is a real God, which His Word says that He is near. God bless you and keep multiplying each offering that you give to missions.
