Happy to report that all is well with my family. The girls are really growing up. Ayla sat her national exams that will qualify her for secondary (High School). We are confident she will top the island if not come in the first three. She is doing very well in her Violin and Piano classes. She will soon be playing at church.

Aasia got baptized in February. She too is in music class learning the Piano. She is also doing extremely well at school. She is a testifier and will do it at any given opportunity.

Anesta continues to be instrumental in the work here and has a growing Sunday school both spiritually and physically. She runs the clothes pantry distributing clothes to all three works. It's a labor of Love for her.

Oasis Baptist Church (In the village of Mt. Rich)

This is a new work just getting off the ground. We had 2 weeks of meeting from May 17th – May 28th.
