Dear Supporting Friends.

Greetings to you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. I pray that all is well. I am happy to report since I last reported that several exciting things happened and continues to progress.

My family is doing well the kids are grow faster than we can keep up with. Ayla continues to do excellent in school toping her class for the past two school terms with averages of 98.9 and 99.6 respectively. She has made a profession of on Sunday morning March 3<sup>rd</sup>. She continues to sing, learning new songs all the time. She will be getting baptized Sunday May 19<sup>th</sup> along with some other converts. Aasia and my wife Anesta are doing well. Anesta continues to be a real helpmate and a great asset in the works here in Grenada in which we are involved.

The work in Chantimelle is steadily progressing. We have started work on the building we are still in the foundation stage since we had to do some extra work there. Things are taking shape and looking good. So far, we have dug about 500 feet of trenches @ 3ft wide and has cut bended and put in place about 300 length of 20 ft rebars (steel) 1/2", 3/8" and 5/8". We poured 12" cement in 250 ft of trenches @ 3 ft in width and laid about 500, 8" concrete blocks for foundation and have filled the holes with concrete. We had churches coming and helping. This was a description of some of what was done so far, and we give God the glory.

Brother Joseph Thomas, the man I have stationed at Chantimelle, is a great worker along with his wife. We had two professions last Sunday the 14<sup>th</sup> of March 2019, while out street preaching. We have visitors regularly. Please continue to pray for the building project that needs be met. We had a man approached us about getting married and joining the church remember that in prayer. We are working on building and God is still working on hearts.

The work here at Victory Baptist too is moving on well. As I mentioned above, we look forward to baptism May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019. We had 6 professions of faith for the first quarter of the year and have increased our population of teenagers. We supported many of the nights of tent meetings held by some of the other Baptist churches on the island had. We also had pastor Jeff Faggart from NC for a week in January it was a great week. He preached some excellent sermons, some on Baptist history. Learning of our heritage left our people well encouraged. Continue to pray for us here for souls as priority, baptism, our young people and needs as they arises.

We again say thank you for your faithful support in prayers, financially and otherwise.

We will continue to pray for you.
