Dear Friends,

We are at the end of the third quarter of the year. The days are getting more and more uncertain. We couldn't have anticipated the things that transpired during the past three months. We simply couldn't be sure of anything. The one thing we are always sure of is the goodness of the Lord and His grace and love for lost sinners. He has displayed time and time again His care for us and has graciously given us to be out and about His work. We thank Him for His provision for us as a family and His care for the ministry.

Over here, things are well. We are getting Matt ready for school, which starts on September 27. He starts the fifth grade this year. As for Stella, she continues to work with children, teaching one of the Sunday school classes in Sanguera. And she does a great job doing that. The back pain that she experiences does not seem to slow her down. We ask that you help us pray that the Lord would help her with that and take the pain away.

Like last year, school holidays months haven't been that different from the rest of the months, except maybe that there hasn't been school. Due to the restrictions still in place, we haven't been able to conduct a single of the activities or programs that we normally hold during these months.

The positive thing is that everyone knows and understands the situation that has called for all the restraint.

The ministry continues to be affected by the restrictions. But it's encouraging to know that the pandemic seems to ebb here. We are really hoping and praying for things to return to normal.

In the midst of all this, the ministry of reconciliation continues. We did evangelism as we could and as the Lord enabled us. The gospel was shared in all the locations where we have a church. A few other villages, where we currently have no permanent work, were also reached with the Good News. In His goodness, the Lord saved 29 people.

We would like to thank God for everyone in whose heart the Lord put to respond to the needs that were mentioned in our last prayer letter. We were very touched by the response to the needs. The church in northern Ghana has its walls completely daubed with cement plaster and ready for painting. The congregation of the church in Toumone couldn't be happier to be blessed with a new concrete floor and a set of speaker with two wireless microphones. We got the same small PA set for the church in Kpindjieme and Kolo. May the Lord bless every one of you for helping with these needs!

As for the church in the village of Abobo, they very happily welcomed the news of the construction of a better church building for them. We had meetings with the church leaders and discussed how the construction is to be done. It was decided that the current church building will be used by children for Sunday school, as they current meet in the open under no structure. We plan for works to launch the first of October. We are still mobilizing some of the work materials and getting the workers ready for things to launch come October. Very soon, a new God-honoring building will be erected in the village there.
