Would receiving good news make you merry?

Colossians 1:21 . . . And you that were sometimes alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled.

Christ, you can, one day, be reunited with those Christian loved ones and friends who have gone by way of death.

1 Thessalonians 4:16 . . . for the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first.

4:17 . . . Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.
