S ATISFACTION (The Abundant Life)



These four things you must know before you can be saved.

- 1. ROM. 3:23 FOR ALL HAVE SINNED AND COME SHORT OF THE GLOFN OF GOD. (You must realize you are a sinner.)
- PROM. 6:23 FOR THE WAGES OF SIN IS
 DEATH, BUT THE GIFT OF GOD IS
 ET RNAL FE THROUGH JESUS
 CHRIST OUR LORD. (You must realize
 you are condemned by sin.)
- ROM. 5:8 BUT GOD COMMENDETH HIS LOVE TOWARD US IN THAT WHILE WE WERE YET SINNERS CHRIST DIED FOR US. (You must realize that Jesus Christ paid your debt on the cross.)
- ROM. 10:13 FOR WHOSOEVER SHALL CALL UPON THE NAME OF THE LORD SHALL BE SAVED. (Realize that salvation is a gift of God, and accept it by faith.)



After a person is saved, there are five basic areas of obadience to maintain a stable Christian life.

- 1. THE FIRST STEP OF OBEDIENCE IS BAPT SM. (Romans 6:1-5) (Acts 8:37, 39)
- LOCAL CHURCH MEMBERSHIP, AND FAITHFULNESS TO THE SERVICES. (Acts 2:41-47) Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together. (Heb. 10:25)
- DAILY BIBLE READING. They searched the scriptures daily. (Acts 17:11)
- DAILY PRAYER. Pray without ceasing. (I Thess. 5:17)
- BE A FAITHFUL DAILY WITNESS FOR CHRIST. He that winneth souls is wise. (Prov. 11:30)



Results of an obedient Christian life. John 10:10

- 1. (LOVE) AND WE KNOW THAT ALL THINGS WORK TOGETHER FOR GOOD TO THEM THAT LOVE GOD, TO THEM WHO ARE THE CALLED ACCORDING TO HIS PURPOSE. Romans 8:28
- (JOY) THESE THINGS HAVE I SPOKEN UNTO YOU, THAT MY JOY MIGHT REMAIN IN YOU, AND THAT YOUR JOY MIGHT BE FULL.
 John 15:11
- (PEACE) AND THE PEACE OF GOD, WHICH PASSETH ALL UNDERSTAND-ING, SHALL KEEP YOUR HEARTS, AND MINDS THROUGH CHRIST JESUS. Phil. 4:7
- 4. (FREEDOM FROM FEAR) FOR GOD HATH NOT GIVEN US THE SPIRIT OF FEAR, BUT OF POWER, AND OF LOVE, AND OF A SOUND MIND. II Tim. 1:7
