We want to share with you what we have done in the last months in the work of La Lima with the help of the Lord:

1. We have been winning souls in a nearby village to La Lima called La Sabana, about some 25 minutes of distance in which we have reached some 10 people. There is much need of the Gospel in this place.
2. Also we have started services in homes in a new area called the Bendicion de Dios. There we have been able to reach some 6 adults and some children. In both places we desire to start a work there, but it will be God that will send workers at His time.
3. This year we have observed a considerable spiritual growth in the brethren and with more interest in serving the Lord and to accomplish the mandate of the Great Commission, in spite that looks easy, it still keeps being a strong struggle among our Baptist churches.
4. We have started a missionary fund that is destined the offering of every first Sunday of the month for the missionary fund. We have a enormous moral debt and a profound gratitude for those pastors and churches that support missions and we admired that. However we ask your prayers so God can provide financial support for this missionary family as well with other missionaries that day after day struggle for the support of their families in Honduras.
5. We ask your prayers because this coming year we will start with our project for the pastoral house because since 3 years ago, we have been living practically in the Sunday School rooms with a small room that we were able to have, thanks to some of the support of some brethren.
6. We still need some various important projects like the restoration of the altar (Preaching platform) and in addition an adequate nursery room for the small children.
7. Lastly, we are praying for a bus because our church in spite being in a central area, the majority of the brethren live in farther areas.
