Thank you for your prayers and support. I have just returned from another trip to Honduras. On this trip we were able to go into some new areas. We flew into San Pedro Sula where Bro. Mario Zavala was waiting for us to arrive. We then drove about 5 hours to the capital city of Tegucigalpa and spent time with Bro. Carlos Ochoa. The next morning we had bible clubs for the children and preaching to the adults in a village. That evening we had service in Bro. Ochoa's church, they are currently meeting in a school room that the Lord has provided for them to use. He showed me 3 different areas that the Lord has laid on his heart to start good Independent Baptist Churches.

We then drove to La Paz, about 1.5 hours away to be with Bro. Edwin Perez. That night after settling into our motel, we heard gun shots outside that lasted about all night. All through the night, cars were racing down the little dirt street in front of the motel and we would hear shots, as if they were shooting at the cars. By daybreak, things had settled down and we were on our way to a town where Bro. Edwin had young and old ready to hear the gospel. While we were with Bro. Edwin, we realized that he had need of a bicycle because he has no transportation. The team decided to pitch in and get him a bicycle. We also met the need of a young man in his church that needed school uniforms and supplies to start trade school. Praise the Lord that we were able to help out.

That evening, we traveled to Sonaguera to be with Bro. Josue Andrade where we did several bible clubs, preached in several of the churches and on the radio also. The team split up several times while



we were there so we could cover more areas. The Lord blessed in all of these services and souls were saved. We then traveled to Tela, about 2.5 hours out of Sonaguera, where we met up with Pastor Napoleon and Esther Flores. That evening we were in service with him and his church family and it was a real blessing to preach in his church. The next day we were with Bro. Axil Urbina in his mission work in Toyos. Angi taught the little girls, Bro. Henry Moose taught a lesson to the little boys,

then Bro. Rob and sister Pam Abernethy taught the boys, Bro.

Joe Hendricks taught the teens and I was able to preach to the adults. That afternoon, we split into 2 groups. One group went to the prison where Bro. Joe preached and the



other group went to San Juan Pueblo about 45 minutes away where I got to preach in a town they call "Little Columbia" because of the drugs and crime. We had a great time there. Bro. Ernesto and I were able to go out soul winning in the village before the service and the Lord added to the church 3 souls. We had a great service and one lady got assurance of her salvation. The next day we traveled back to San Pedro Sula to be at our Children's Home, Alpha & Omega. We loved seeing the children. We bought pizza and ate with the children and had a great time there.

We had a great time in Honduras, the people there are very receptive to the gospel and I look forward to seeing them again. Thank you to all who gave to make this trip possible.

There is much work still to be done around the world, everywhere we go, there are people who are not born again and it is my desire to win as many as possible to the Lord Jesus Christ. This year we will be travelling a lot, not just outside the country but in the US as well. Our country needs to repent!
