Dear Co-Laborers and Friends,

Thanks be to God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ from whom cometh all blessings both physical and spiritual. Glory, honor and praise to his name and in all accomplishment he had performed through us now and he will in the years to come. *"For by him were all things created... and by him all things consist."* (Colossians 1:16, 17)

Hope it is well with everyone and the church at large. This year seems to pass by so quickly leaving behind many challenges as well, blessings to share. I do thank the Lord for his goodness such as being still alive, good health, traveling mercies, preaching opportunities and the joy of meeting new families, pastors and churches of like faith. Even the long lasting friendship that was established among many of those we have crossed paths with. I would like to thank the pastor and the church for your constant labor of love whether it be in prayers, friendship and/or in financial support.

Brethren, my heart's desire is to get home soon and get started because we know perfectly that the end of time is approaching. My home church, Mt-Hagen Baptist Temple, is ready to stand beside me, the people are eager for the Gospel, and the field is white unto harvest. However I have yet to pick up the remaining 60% of my support before I leave for home. I do realize the uprising fact of the financial burden of this country for which many of our churches and families of like faith are greatly affected, and so the process of raising support will take a little longer than what I expected it to. This means that I may have to stay through the rest of this year and the spring quarter of next year before I will be able to head for home. Meanwhile my earnest desire and prayers, to God first of all, is to properly manage the finances that are already coming in from churches that are currently supporting me. I am glad that my mission board, Fundamental Baptist Home Missions, is fully in charge of receiving and sending my support to me. And secondly, I really want to get done with the rest of my remaining percentage so that I can get out in the field as soon as possible. I strongly believe that God answers prayer in mysterious ways; but he does work through his very people which are his church. I am also praying for any individuals plus churches of those that have a burden for the world missions and still have open doors for new foreign missionaries; that they would be able to take me on and be partakers together in God's missions program. Pray with me that at my visit, God would miraculously work in their hearts causing them to make God honoring decisions as they feel the Lord's burden in their heart for the lost and may seek Gods direction and complete peace to do so.

I have already made up my mind not to spend more of God's precious and countless time raising support for other projects like, land payment (\$3,000), church building (\$5,000), vehicle (\$6,000), PA system for Out-Reaches with a complete set of instruments (\$1,000), projector set for films (\$400.00), Walk about Saw Mill (chain saw), or an Old fashion tent for special meetings. Although these are all very constructive, vital and needed elements to help speed up the church planting process of Local Indigenous Fundamental Independent Baptist Churches in the least amount of time; it is not my main

concern right now. My ultimate or prime concern is to reach the goal of my monthly support which is \$1000, and if I possibly reach that amount; without any delay and but the little help of getting KJV Bibles, gospel tracts, bible institute materials, youth and Sunday school materials plus a plane ticket in my hand, I will be ready for my flight home. I know the Lord will provide these other needs in his own time as long as I am out there doing what he wants me to do.

I am specifically praying for either 20 churches to take me on for \$25 to \$30 per month or 10 churches for \$50 to \$60 per month. This should help me reach the other 60% of my goal. I am not trying to limit the hand or the power of God's countless blessings, but for to clearly present the views and status of where I am at and what I have yet need of. Of course, we all know and believe that God blesses every cheerful giver.

I do solemnly believe with all my heart that one fine day, through this ministry, the Local Indigenous Baptist Churches will be able to stand on their own knowing what it means to give cheerfully, and would cheerfully worship God in their giving of tithes and offerings, local missions, foreign missions and every other form of giving just like the churches and the people of God here in the States are doing; even to the point where we could send missionaries out to foreign fields.

Again with much being said, I would kindly like to thank you all for helping me stand firm and solid in the Word and to feel the joy of knowing that there is not a better place for me to be, but to be in the service of God doing exactly what he wants me to do and to pursue further into achieving much greater exploits for his glory so that fruit may abound in your account and mine.

My constant prayer for the church is that may the Lord continue to bless and extend the borders of your ministries, and that much greater exploits and achievements will be between now and the return of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Until next time . . . God Bless!
