Dear Brethren and Appreciated Pastors:

For me it is a pleasure to greet you and desire that you are found enjoying the blessings of God in your lives and ministries. I would like to report for this means the advance of the Gospel in this region of the state of Puebla, "The door of the Mixed People."

We started the year with a campaign of GROWTH. We called it "Give Me That Mountain." The vision was that during ten weeks we will commit to take one per week, so to have at the end ten contacts to invite for the day of the church anniversary the following 25th of March. Only ten brothers committed themselves: My family and 4 more, so we are waiting 100 new visitors for that day. On February 5, we had the campaign, "Christ the best gift." We offered gifts and we gave the Gospel to 94 new children. In that same occasion, we were able to invite the parents on February 19 to celebrate "Family Day." Thanks to God we had the help of Pastor Martin Cruz with a group of students of the Mount Sion Bible Institute and we had more than 300 persons. We had 29 people baptized in January and February. We preached the Gospel in the municipal auditorium of Tlapanala, Puebla and in San Juan Amecac, Puebla, with an average of 1000 people. We visited towns each week here of: Colucan, Ayutla, Cacaloxuchilt, Atlixco and Tlapanala. I also preached in a family conference in Queretaro and in Papantala, Veracruz. We passed some 5,000 tracts in these months in the market place, hospital and in the streets. We had gave 40 Bibles to new believers and John and Romans when we went soul winning. WE preached in a home for older adults in Tlapanala and Tepepeayeca, Puebla and in the high school of Tlapanala. Thanks to God we had many professions of faith. We have many contacts to who we can visit but we lack gasoline, time and workers. We are renting some minibuses to bring people of Ayutla, San Nicolas Tolentino and Colucan. In these months we have battled much with our van because we cannot pieces due to being model 1991. We are still finding to put a down payment to a property to eliminate the expenses of rent and in respect of health we have battled a little with high pressure and diabetes. My children are advancing in their studies at home. We need helpers with this. We have not pay much attention these months. In my plan is to pay them more attention during the month of April but it will decrease the evangelistic work. WE ask your prayers for the property, for a van of a more recent model, for a van for routes, more workers, for the health of my wife, my daughter Elizabet and for mine. As well I ask your prayers for the campaign of our anniversary that more than 100 new people will hear the Gospel.

Thanks for your prayers and offerings. WE love you in Christ and we reiterate our commitment with God to glorify His name with our lives, preach the Gospel, edify the saints and living for His glory.
