I pray that this letter finds you doing well. Since January first the Lord has allowed me to lead 4 men to Him at the prison, as well as plant many seeds in the hearts of others. I am looking forward to what the Lord is going to do the rest of the year.

As some of you may already know, as of January 1, 2012, Dr. Rennie Campbell, Founder and Director of Living Letters Prison Ministry, resigned as Director of the ministry and appointed me as the new Director of the ministry. Dr. Campbell has been a blessing to me as well as many, many others over the past 20 years. The Lord has used Dr. Campbell to lead literally hundreds of men to the Lord Jesus Christ in the prisons, as well as be a blessing to their families. He has been like a second daddy to me. I am truly honored and humbled to serve in his place. As far as my responsibilities, nothing will really change. I will still continue to do what I have been for some time now as a missionary chaplain at Livesay Correctional Institution in Spartanburg, SC; as well as go to other prisons in South and North Carolina and any others that the Lord may open the door for us to enter. I pray that the Lord will continue to bless the ministry in the future as he has in the past. I ask that you continue to pray for myself and Brother Joe Hendricks as we both pray and seek the Lord's direction concerning the prison ministries in both states and that the Lord will send forth more laborers into the harvest. Right now we are the only two full-time missionaries in our ministry. However we do have several men who help us with many of the services that we have each week and each month in different prisons. Our prayer is that the Lord will call more into full-time service in the prisons for the harvest is truly white, ripe unto harvest. That being said, I ask you to pray for our first Revival of the year at Livesay Correctional Institution in Spartanburg, SC. It will start on March 8<sup>th</sup> and go through the 10<sup>th</sup>. Please pray for souls to be saved and Christians to be revived.

In closing, I just wanted to thank you all once again for your faithful prayers and support over the years.
