We are thankful to the Lord for His manifold blessing on us throughout this year. Difficulties were part of this year too but the grace and the goodness of the Lord have been experienced throughout. We thank Him for you and for your faithful support and prayers all through this year.

We are encouraged by the turnout of our evangelism efforts this quarter. Seeing souls saved has always been a rewarding experience for us. We did a lot of door-to-door witnessing and visitation in several areas. We felt the need to do so because we've been noticing neglect and/or slackness on the part of some for the task that has been left for us to do. Thus, 35 souls received Christ in the 5 different localities that we targeted. We also baptized 5 souls in Sanguera and 4 in Tsevié.

The church there was very positively impacted and the brethren there, including the pastor, very encouraged. Salvation decisions have also been registered in our other ministry localities as well.

Please continue to pray for the work we're starting in the village of Afagnan. We're still waiting on the Lord to provide for the construction of the church there. Souls are hungry for the Word in that place and we're eager to see the Lord change lives there.

We are very excited about the leadership training program that is now underway. We currently have two schools in progress to train some men for the ministry. A total of 25 men are being trained now. Our national pastors are very happy about the program as they understand that men can now be trained, who will help carry the gospel further and assist in strengthening the local churches. A third school is getting ready to start as of this writing. Please pray for us as we teach these men. Do remember the men being trained also in your prayers. Our desire is that they be regular and continue strong until graduation. We are very encouraged by the keen interest they exhibit and their hunger for the knowledge of the Word of God.

The Lord provided the motorcycle for Bro. Christian. He now is able to get around without much trouble. He was elated and very appreciative of the goodness of the Lord. We pray that He will richly bless the dear friend He'd used for this purpose. Please continue to pray for Bro. Christian. The work there is going well. We have some outreach activities planned there around Christmastime. The goal is to reach the immediate vicinities surrounding the church site. We will be targeting both children and adults. Please keep us in prayer as we try to reach these people with the gospel. And pray that Bro. Christian and his family will be greatly used of the Lord.
