Randolph got saved three years ago the first time he came to see me, ever since he has remained faithful to the Lord. Please pray for this young couple as they seek to please the Lord and grow in the knowledge of our Savior. We are very excited for them.



I am in the prison once a month with fellow servants, each service I am there we would see one or more inmate come up to ask Jesus to save them. It blesses our heart to see men waiting to hear the word of God. I am also thankful for my Job accommodating me leave each month, so I can be in the prison ministry. I have been praying much lately for a new job close to home; while my heart is also burdening to do more for the Lord. Another prison door has been open and some schools where we can reach even more inmates and children with the gospel.

We recently acquired a piece of land to lease. Which USD \$500.00 is still needed to pay before we can begin to build. The Church needs a more stable location (Our current location is a temporary one, at any time we can be asked to move) and a comfortable place of worship (our current place of worship is a shed without outer walls; most time with heavy wind and rain everyone in the church gets wet). My family also needs a home (we're renting). Our prayer is to build a home with size enough to also house the Church.



We would also like to register our Church in keeping with the law of our land. USD \$400.00 is needed to have this process and paper work completed.

Thank you in advance for praying for these needs. Hopefully and prayerfully our next prayer letter will confirm the go ahead for us to start building a place for home and Church.

Mom's foot has seen some improvement with the herbal treatment she is presently receiving. Mom and Dad would like to thank everyone for their generous support to help with the medical expenses.
