It a blessing to be able to write to you again concerning my family and the ministry here in Bequia over the past few months. God is good! We continue to be grateful for your prayers and support.

Most recently the devastation left behind by hurricanes in certain Caribbean countries continues to be highly concerning. Our brothers and sisters have been hit really hard. Here in Bequia we had only a bit of damage by comparison; Broken roads, landslides. I had to cut our porch to get the water to run under the house instead of inside. We had a lot of water coming through the property. But do pray for those who have been more severely affected.

One of the highlights of the pass few months has been our VBS. We had the help of Tamana Baptist church in Trinidad. They came over and were a real blessing for that week. Over the duration of the VBS we were blessed to see 7 souls receive

Christ. PRAISE GOD! Many of these children now attend our children's bible sessions on Fridays.

Our daughter just turned 1 year on October 13th and Zedekiah is growing well almost ready for school. Both children and I was granted 2 years of residence. And God once again provided the \$1600EC that was needed to secure it.

We are starting out the month of November with a few days of evangelistic meetings. So please pray for souls to be saved. We were able to relay our church porch flooring with concrete, however concerning the sewage tank we are awaiting the last bit of materials to complete it, for most of the work has already been done. Keep praying concerning the well, as we seek to finish those projects presently in motion and then get the well started.

My wife has had the opportunity to teach the staff on the islands special Education school (Sunshine School), American sign language. We thank God for that opportunity! So remember her in prayer in this new ministry.

The young man by the name of Sherlon Pompey whom I have frequently mention in previous newsletter, has sadly gone back into alcoholism. After the recent passing of his mother he resorted to alcohol to remedy the pain. He is still on the island I still have contact with him, so remember him.

God has been so good over the pass months He continues to take care of us from day to day. Thank you for allowing His working in your lives and ministry so much that it has been a blessing to us right here in Bequia.
