It has been around 12 years of knowing him and he is a good friend. He is thinking of a move from La Ceiba to Puerto Cortes, keep that in prayer.

1. Report of the Ministry

- In La Camisa 8 children received Christ.

2. Financial Burdens:

I want to express with great sorrow that my financial situation is difficult, for several reasons:

- The Divine Grace Church is having a critical moment. The offerings are relatively few. Most members are women, and the few men I have, some of them are unemployed, so the church does what it can to help, but not enough to cover my basic needs. The church on occasion does not have to pay for electric service.
- My car needs an urgent change of tires and engine oil leaks.
- And most importantly I can not help my children in their education.

It is not pleasant for me to say this, but I do it for my desire to serve the Lord and do his work and I know you have the heart for the Lord's servants. Therefore I request financial support to do the work better and longer.

I express my sorrow and understanding as we all have difficulties. The amount deemed appropriate is \$400.00. I would urge you to look at my proposal; if it were possible it would be of great help to me, my family and to continue serving in the work of God.
