We give thanks to God for what He has done in these last months in His work here in Tegucigalpa, being witnesses of how the Holy Spirit of God convicts the sinner and making him come to the Way that is Christ, the Lord.

This year we started three ministries of evangelism that our Lord has put in our hearts. The first one is to evangelize in the streets of our city. There is many children, young people inhaling glue, living in the streets without their parents, others selling candy in the corners where there street lights and others abused by adults. Many of these young people are rejected. The people in their vehicles close their windows so they will not have contact with them, they are not only hungry for material food, but also with thirst and hunger of spiritual food.

In second place, we have started to work in the hospitals. Many sick abandon without anyone to visit them, taking them the Gospel of Jesus Christ and encouraging those that know the Lord, because even Christians are forgotten in the hospitals.

In third place, we start to work in the prisons of men, woman and young people in centers of rehabilitation. In prison, we are found with women that live together with their children. In the prison with young people that were deceived to commit crime and sadly without responsible parents.

The harvest is plenteous and the laborers are few. My city Tegucigalpa is like many cities with a great need of churches to go out of their comfort of their four walls, meanwhile we will keep working because with one being saved, it was worth it.

With those that take time to read this letter, I just ask for your prayers for strength, health and God can use us to keep proclaiming the precious Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

In addition I have a request for something material. The car that we use in the work needs repairs, practically a new motor. We found a motor and has a value of 12,000 lempiras or about \$600 dollars. I ask your support in prayer and if you desire to support us financially, it will be welcome your help.
