Dear Pastor and Church,

It is an honor to be able to write to you, hoping that the Lord has shed blessings in your lives and hearts. In continuation, I want to share what our God is letting us do here in Atiquizaya.

Since our last letter that we wrote to you, God is working in many ways in our church and with His congregation. During the month of March, we covered the theme of the BATTLE. We learned about the Christian armor and how we need to maintain strong in the Lord. It was of much blessing to see how the men and women of the church took a commitment to be faithful to God.

In this month, we had two Bible clubs in different strategic areas of the municipal. The first one was in the area of El Escorial, this is the route of visitation of my wife in which we had 30 boys and girls, in which 4 were saved. The second was in the area of San Esteban, 35 boys and girls came and 20 were saved. We planned these Bible clubs a long time ago and we saw the hand of God moving in the lives of those children.

My wife, Sister Leyda, is of much blessing to the work and to me. I wouldn't know what it would be like for me without her help. She teaches the Sunday school class of the young ladies and has about 15 young ladies per Sunday while I teach the children, teens and adults. Also we have now a Super Church class for the boys and girls under 11 years old in the second hour of the church. In the same hour, I preach to the church in general. For the grace of God we have taken out some of the wooden benches because we have already 18 plastic chairs but we need more. The men and ladies of the church feel very blessed to have them and they enjoy the preaching. We can see many more brethren being saved and adding themselves to take part of the work.

For now I have a secular job. The majority part of the day, I am in Santa Ana. I feel that I am not taking care of the work as I suppose to because I am not able to dedicate the time. I ask that you remember us in your prayers because we need more finances for the work and for my family. But I am sure that my God is working in many ways in our lives and He will supply what we lack according to His will.

Here I share with you some activities and prayer requests so you can help us pray:

1. Get more financial support.
2. Vigils and fasting programmes throughout the year.
3. Legal organization of the local church.
4. Chairs for the adults (auditorium) and for the children (Sunday school).
5. A microbus for the soul winning group.

I give thanks to my Father for Christian brothers and sisters that remember us in their prayers and that sustain us with their financial support. It is for God and for you that we are in the mission field. We love you!
