II Chronicles 2:12

Beloved Pastor and Dear Brethren in Christ Jesus:

Meanwhile, we breathe an environment of much insecurity and that has given us valuable opportunities to witness because only my Blessed Jesus Christ can bring true peace.

December: It has been very difficult to struggle with the problem of my back these two months because the winter in our country. The climate is rainy and very cold. I am having more pain. I have another date programmed to see the neurosurgeon this month of January. . Please pray for the provision of the Lord because I don't have medical insurance so our support is affected with medical and hospital expenses. In Christmas and New Year we had different activities with dinners, time of fellowship and singing to strengthen the unity of the church because some brethren are without work.

January: We realize a camp the first days of this month and the last week we celebrated Children's Bible clubs in the three churches. Almost 300 attended with parents, children and young people. WE preached the Word of God, people were saved, with the blessing of God and the offerings of some brethren. We also gave out book bags and school supplies.
